

## Goldman Sachs *10,000 Small Businesses* at Babson College Curriculum

The *10,000 Small Businesses* at Babson curriculum focuses on developing skills that you can apply immediately to address the issues most critical to growing your business. The curriculum is broken down as follows:

- Week one is technology onboarding where scholars will learn about the systems they will be using in the program and booking their flights for the in-person sessions at Babson College
- The next three weeks (Orientation and Blocks 1-2) of the program scholars will spend 10-12 hours per week from home completing online coursework and engaging in group learning sessions
- Participants will next attend the first of two four-day sessions (Blocks 3-6) at Babson College
- Program participants will then return to online work (Blocks 7-10) where they spend around 10-12 hours per week from home completing online coursework and engaging in group learning sessions
- The second, and final, face-to-face session (Blocks 11-14) at Babson College will also be four days and include presentation of growth plans/graduation

In addition to the classroom experience, the Goldman Sachs *10,000 Small Businesses* program will:

- Provide one-on-one advisory services to help you develop your tailored plan for growth
- Provide networks through outside volunteers participating as panelists, pitch advisors and legal experts

## Schedule Details

- **General Information**
  - Scholars will be assigned sections and growth groups upon acceptance
  - All Online WebEx sessions and Face-to-Face on campus sessions are mandatory!
  - Scholars will need computers with camera, microphone or headset, and Internet access. Laptops at in-person sessions is strongly encouraged.
- **Weekly schedule**
  - Every block will kick off on Monday, with a scheduled WebEx session in the afternoon or evening (the time of the session depends on the section you are assigned – WebEx start times are 5:00pm, 5:30pm, 6:30pm, and 7:00pm EST)
  - Every block will end on Friday with a scheduled WebEx session in the afternoon or evening (the time of the session depends on the section you are assigned)
  - During the week, scholars will work at their own pace, with the goal of completing assignments for the Friday closing session
  - Exercises for discussion will be available on Tuesday
  - Scholars are expected to be active on the discussion boards Tuesday through Friday
  - Often on Saturdays, many scholars will continue to discuss the work for the week among their peers, and continue to work on their growth plans
  - Work weeks may also include independent meetings with your assigned Virtual Business Advisor
- **Independent Growth Plan Work Weeks**
  - At the start of designated growth plan work weeks, each Virtual Business Advisor will conduct a growth group session on Monday evening (the time of the session depends on the section you are assigned)
  - Work weeks also include independent meetings with your Virtual Business Advisor
